## **GET INTO**

### **Short Courses That Develop Young People's Skills In A Specific Sector And Support Them Into Jobs**

Each Get into course is designed according to the sector in which it is run and is developed with employers. It aims to give young people, who are work-ready but do not have vocational skills, a mixture of practical training and hands on experience that will enable them to get a job. It also provides them with the opportunity to meet potential employers and receive support for six months after the course.

#### **How does it help young people?**

##### **Participants can:**

- Attend a 'Taster Day' to have a go and see if the course is for them
- Learn new skills in a specific area of work
- Get practical experience of work
- Improve their employability skills, including communication, teamwork, reliability and hard work
- Stage a final presentation, in which they say what they have learnt
- Meet potential employers
- Get six months follow up support

#### **Who is eligible? Young people aged between 16-25 who:**

- Educational Underachievers (including young people with low basic skills)
- Offenders and Ex-Offenders and those at risk of Offending
- Long Term Unemployed
- In or leaving care

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> February – 6<sup>th</sup> March 2009 we are running a 'Get Into Hospitality' in Rhyl in partnership with Working Links. Activities on the course will include help with your CV, interview techniques, food hygiene and a guaranteed interview with a prospective employer at the end of the course.
