

LIFEGUARD TRAINING

Eighteen unemployed individuals started a two week training course to become qualified Lifeguards on 20th February 2009. The course has been designed to give participants the qualifications required by local employers to fill job vacancies. The training is funded by the Welsh Assembly Government and has been delivered by North Wales Training and Clwyd Leisure Services on behalf of the Rhyl City Strategy. Qualifications include First at Work, Certificate in Swimming Pool Supervision and Rescue and Award in Basic Pool Plant Operations.
